CORTINA ONE OF EUROPE'S TOP MOUNTAIN DESTINATIONS

Cortina d'Ampezzo, or simply Cortina, is a gem of sheer beauty in the heart of the Alps. Set in the wide and sunny Ampezzo Valley, the small town is surrounded in all directions by some of the most scenic peaks of the Dolomite mountains, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

AN ALPINE CLASSIC

Over 1000 years of inhabitation have endowed the town with a set of precious **traditions**, a rich history and its own local language. Cortina was among the first Alpine destinations to host tourists, firstly explorers and scientists, then the royals and aristocrats of several countries; it kept evolving and transforming, remaining at the centre of the stage: Italy's first **Olympic Games** in 1956, the Dolce Vita in the 60s and then the films and film stars, the sparkly 80s...Today, Cortina cherishes its unique blend of local traditions, heritage and **cosmopolitan lifestyle**, all of which makes it a proud member of the **Best of the Alps** association.

A SUPERB SPORTS TOWN

The wide Ampezzo Valley and the Dolomites surrounding it make Cortina one of the best spots for sports enthusiasts and sporting events: the 1956 Winter Olympics, the 2021 World Ski Championships and the Winter Olympics once again in 2026, this time along with Milan.

In the **summer**, it offers hundreds of kilometres of hiking trails, over thirty via ferratas, a golf course and then MTB, road biking and climbing routes. In the **winter**, it provides legendary ski slopes, the Olympic ice stadium,

a vast array of snowshoeing and ski touring options as well as cross-country skiing pistes in the Natural park. What gives Cortina an edge is how sports can be enjoyed in one of the world's most **beautiful mountain environments**.

A RELAXING RETREAT

Wonderful panoramas, comfortable hotels, fresh air and a **picturesque town centre**: Cortina gives its guests all they need to feel good, including great food and some wellness options.

The numerous mountain huts provide a cosy ambiance and hearty, **traditional food**, while awarded restaurants add that extra creativity and innovation and Alpine farms deliver local products and natural food. Another ingredient for a relaxing holiday in the Dolomites are the spa areas of many of Cortina's hotels and the **wellness experiences** offered by local professionals.

SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Due to its long tradition in tourism, Cortina has a lot to offer in terms of services and infrastructure.

You will find the right **accommodation** for many types of clients: mountain lodges and camping sites for adventure seekers, apartments and hotels for a comfortable stay, agriturismi and alpine farms for a holiday in contact with nature and luxury hotels for that extra touch.

Mountain **professionals** and ski instructors are available to help guests make the most of their Dolomite experience in complete safety in all seasons, while the town centre has many **shops, bars** and **restaurants** for guests to find all they need.



HOW TO GET TO CORTINA

ALL MEANS OF TRANSPORT TO GET TO CORTINA D'AMPEZZO



BY AIR ✈

The main gateway to Cortina is Venice's Marco Polo Airport, with regular bus links to Cortina. Other airports in the area are Treviso Canova, Innsbruck Kranebitten and Verona Catullo, while larger airports such as Milan Malpensa and Munich's Joseph Strauss are also an option. Cortina can be reached by helicopter transfer at the Heliport of Fiammes. Further information and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".

BY TRAIN AND BUS 🚆

The closest train stations are Calalzo to the south and Dobbiaco to the north, both around 30 km away from Cortina. Cortina is linked to Venice, its airport and its mainland train station of Mestre, by several bus companies. Regional buses link Cortina to other towns in the area, including Dobbiaco and Calalzo. BY CAR

Cortina is crossed by route SS51 in a North-South direction and the SS 48bis of the Dolomites in an East-West direction. The former can be taken exiting Motorway A27 Venezia-Belluno at the exit Pian di Vedoia. Cortina is located:

- 162 km from Venice (about a 2h15 drive)
- 432 km from Milan (about a 4h45 drive)
- 165 km from Innsbruck (about a 3h drive)

TRANSFER

In Cortina there are several companies offering transfer services for small or large groups within Cortina and from/to airports and train stations, as well as private transfers for events, lunches and dinners. They also offer transport of equipment and luggage for ski tours, ski safaris and multthey offer daily tours to visit neighboring cities and areas such as Venice, Dolomite valleys and lakes, Innsbruck and the Prosecco hills. SUMMER ACTIVITIES

A SUPERB SPORTS TOWN FOR A SUMMER HOLIDAY IN THE DOLOMITES

A UNIQUE SETTING, A LONG TRADITION

Summer and autumn are magical seasons in Cortina. During the summer, the green dominates the valley, from the meadows to the woods to the high mountain pastures. In autumn, the colours of the foliage combined with the incredible panorama of the valley make Cortina a dream destination.

Cortina has a very **long tradition in summer sports**, as it was among the first Alpine destinations to host tourists, firstly explorers, mountaineers and scientists, then the royals and aristocrats.

A WIDE VARIETY OF SUMMER ACTIVITIES

Today, the wide Ampezzo Valley is still one of the best spots in the Italian Alps for sports enthusiasts and nature lovers: the unique wide and sunny valley surrounded by the Dolomites make it possible to practise various sports: there are over 400 km of **hiking** trails of all lengths and difficulties, from simple ones, also reachable by lift, to hut-to-hut multi-day hikes and itineraries in wild and remote settings. Cortina is famous for having the highest number of **via ferrata routes** in Dolomites, a way to enable everyone - also beginners and families - to live an exciting experience and reach the top of a mountain, one of the most beautiful and spectacular areas for **climbing** in the entire Alps. In Cortina there are over 1,000 traditional and modern routes and many crags equipped for sport climbing, with different

characteristics and settings. Another way to explore Cortina is on two wheels: mountain **biking** along the numerous trails, e-biking for a more relaxing experience or road biking along the spectacular mountain passes. Lastly, Cortina has a 9-hole **golf** course in one of the most enchanting settings of the Alps.

A HEARTY CUISINE

The final touch that makes these activities unforgettable is the **local hearty cuisine**. The countless mountain huts and alpine farms scattered around town and on the mountains are not only a shelter but they can become a fundamental part of the holiday experience as it is possible to stay there overnight, watching incredible sunrises and sunsets, experience their traditional warm hospitality and hearty cuisine.

INDIVIDUAL & GROUP OPTIONS

Some of the **activities** proposed in this section are **individual**, others can be enjoyed also in **groups**. Cortina's **mountain professionals** are available to make the experience even more enjoyable and safe. In the chapter "Useful information and services", you will find all the information and contact details of professionals and of the services related to the activities: mountain professionals, mountain bike guides, skipass options, rental shops, transfer services, etc.

HIKING & TREKKING

Cortina offers over **400 km** of signposted hiking trails through meadows and forests, Alpine lakes and the **Natural Park of the Ampezzo Dolomites**. There are trails of **all difficulties** and **lengths**, making Cortina an ideal destination for both well-trained hikers and for those who want to enjoy peaceful walks admiring breathtaking views. Wonderful panoramas go hand in hand with pleasures of the palate: a hike is not complete without a visit to one of the many **mountain lodges** or **Alpine farms**, for a hearty lunch or a refreshing drink. Many hiking areas and huts can be reached by **lift**. This enables everyone to reach enchanting locations high up in the mountains. In order to experience a full immersion in the Dolomites it is possible to do **multi-day hikes**, going from hut to hut and sleeping in traditional mountain lodges along the way, admiring stunning **sunrises** and **sunsets** and living the warm hospitality of the traditional huts. The **mountain guides**, **nature guides** and **trekking guides** of Cortina are available to take individuals and groups for unforgettable hikes. MULTI-DAY HIKES

The most famous multi-stage treks in the Ampezzo Valley are the Alpine Path of the Dolomites N. 1 and the Cortina Dolomiti Ultra Trekking.

ALPINE PATH OF THE DOLOMITES N. 1

The Dolomites "Alta Via" n.1 winds along a route of about **125 km** and **7,300 m in elevation gain** and offers an alternative and authentic way of experiencing the mountain, crossing the heart of the Dolomites. The route, the first, the most classic and the most famous of the great Dolomite itineraries, consists of **12 stages** and connects several municipalities and regions, starting from Lake Braies and arriving in the town of Belluno. Along the way there are many Alpine farms and traditional huts where to get some refreshment and spend the night.



CORTINA DOLOMITI ULTRA TREKKING

The "Cortina Dolomiti Ultra Trekking" is a multi-stage trek of about **7 days with 6 nights in mountain lodges**. It covers a total distance of **132 km** with an **altitude difference** of over **6,700 m**. The trek was designed with the objective of revealing the enchanted locations that are hidden in Cortina and its surroundings, making it possible to experience the Dolomites by hiking from one mountain lodge to the next, walking amongst forests, rivers, lakes and stunning peaks. Cortina's **mountain guides** organize, upon reservation, group hikes along the itinerary.



TRAIL RUNNING

Cortina d'Ampezzo is a running paradise in the Italian Alps. The mountain town offers running enthusiasts a wide variety of trails of different lengths and difficulty, surrounded by very **diverse landscapes** in the heart of the stunning UNESCO World Heritage Dolomites: from the high mountains to the enchanted woods, from high altitude glades to trails between lakes and streams in the **Natural Park of the Ampezzo Dolomites**. Along the trails there are many **mountain lodges**, Alpine farms and agriturismi offering a warm welcome and traditional aromas. Cortina hosts several international racing competitions, making it a particularly popular destination for running lovers, who will have the opportunity to try the tracks of the races first hand: from the **Cortina-Dobbiaco Run** and the **Lavaredo Ultra Trail** competitions in June to the **Delicious Festival Dolomiti** in September.



VIA FERRATA ROUTES

Via ferratas are among the most exciting experiences that one can try in Cortina. These routes up the mountains, **equipped with metal cables, ladders** or other fixed features, including **wooden walkways** and **suspended bridges**, were first created in the Dolomites during the First World War to transport food and weapons. Today, there are **more than 30** via ferratas in Cortina - many of which arriving **above 3,000 m** - making it not just the cradle of this sport, but also one of its hotspots worldwide.

While the most challenging via ferratas are for **expert** mountaineers only, some of the easier ones are suitable for **families** and **children**, if accompanied by a mountain guide. The **rental shops** in town have all the equipment needed to try out this adventurous activity and the **mountain guides** can accompany individuals and groups for the most suitable ferrata. ALPINE CLIMBING

Cortina is one of the most beautiful, classic and spectacular areas for climbing in the entire Alps, with a wide valley magnificently framed by a **crown of mountains in all directions**, many of which **above 3,000 m**. The valley offers over **1,000 traditional and modern routes** of all lengths and difficulties with diverse landscapes and settings. To make the experience more authentic, there are many **mountain huts** where mountaineers can sleep before their endeavour or where they can go for a drink and a well-deserved meal after the climb. The local **mountain guides** can accompany beginners and experienced climbers on hundreds of stunning routes. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".

SPORT CLIMBING

Cortina, in the heart of the Dolomites, is absolutely one of the most **beautiful** and **spectacular locations** for sport climbing. There are **many crags** equipped for sport climbing with **different characteristics** and settings, and for different climbing styles. Among the most famous areas are the Cinque Torri, Cortina's most famous and historically most important climbing location, with routes for every level. The local **mountain guides** offer climbing courses for groups and individuals, for children and adults. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



INDOOR CLIMBING

The indoor climbing centre has over **80 indoor routes** graded from **3b to 8b+** reaching a maximum height of **24 metres** and a route length of up to 30 metres. It is **ideal for beginners**, enabling them to learn in complete safety and develop the basic concepts and more advanced skills during individual and group **climbing courses** with the mountain guides. It's also a good **alternative to outdoor climbing** on rainy days or in the evening. Lastly, the climbing center has a **bar area** with inside and outside tables on a panoramic terrace and a small **conference/meeting room** that can be used for lessons before or after the courses. MOUNTAIN BIKING & E-BIKING

Cortina offers many spectacular itineraries for **every type of MTB enthusiasts**, from scenic routes at altitude and excursions to lush meadows and mountain huts, to downhill routes and challenging tours that require a good level of fitness. The numerous **mountain huts** on the routes also make it possible to taste traditional recipes during well-earned breaks. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



ROAD BIKING

The wide Ampezzo Valley is the ideal location for cycling. Road bike lovers can start from Cortina to explore the **Dolomite passes**, often crossed by the stages of the **Giro d'Italia**, one of the most famous cycling competitions worldwide. The Dolomite roads unwinding from one valley to the next, particularly popular in low season, are among the best known for road cycling in Europe. For the less experienced, the town offers the simple **Lunga Via delle Dolomiti**, a cycle path connecting Cortina to other towns along the route that was once a railway, with a dedicated Bike 'n Bus service. BIKE PARK SOCREPES

Cortina offers bike enthusiasts the Bike Park Socrepes, with **three flow** and **old school trails** at **medium** and **easy levels**, running down the line of the Socrepes chairlift in the Tofana Ski Area. The trails are designed for beginners and experts alike. The downhill trails enable riders to begin practicing posture, techniques and handling, but there are also **technical trail features** and **jumps** for the most experienced bikers. At the bike park there is a nice restaurant, a rental shop and MTB instructors available for a lesson. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".





GOLF

Cortina features a **9 hole golf course** just a few minutes drive from the town centre. The golf course, designed by the famous architect Peter Harradine, is located in the beautiful meadows at the foot of Mount Faloria, in a very **scenic panoramic setting**. Guests can reserve the golf course as well as private lessons or attend courses with professional instructors. The Cortina Golf is enhanced by its Club House, featuring a renowned restaurant. TENNIS & PADDLE

There are **two centres** to play tennis in Cortina: the tennis courts Apollonio, not far from the town centre, and the Tennis Country Club Cortina.

At the **Apollonio**, one can book an outdoor court to play tennis or paddle, as well as private lessons from May to September. The **Tennis Country Club** has a school recognised by the Italian Tennis Federation and organises courses as well as private lessons, also in the winter thanks to its indoor tennis courts.

ADVENTURE PARK CORTINA ADRENALIN CENTER

The Adrenalin Center Adventure Park offers the opportunity to try the **thrill** and the **adrenalin-charged sensation** of being suspended in the treetops. The aptly-named Adrenalin Centre offers **13 equipped routes**, each suitable for different ages and abilities, with 120 passages from tree to tree. Each crossing is different, involving pulleys, rope bridges, cables and nets, with safety and maximum respect for nature as the top priorities. There is also a play-area for children shorter than 1.20 metres. Just next to the Adrenalin Centre there is a snack bar to refresh or have lunch with a tasty panini. WINTER ACTIVITIES

A SUPERB SPORTS TOWN FOR A WINTER HOLIDAY IN THE DOLOMITES

A UNIQUE SETTING, A LONG TRADITION

The wide, sun-kissed Ampezzo Valley is fully surrounded by the Dolomite mountains, making Cortina a **wonderful** spot for **sports enthusiasts** and **nature lovers**. This incredible setting, the many international sporting events and the numerous mountain huts around town make Cortina an ideal destination for snow lovers, for sporting and relaxing holidays.

Winter sports are in the very DNA of Cortina, as the mountain destination hosted in 1956 the first Winter Olympics ever held in Italy, in 2021 the World Ski Championships and in 2026 Cortina will host once again the Winter Olympics, this time alongside Milan.

A WIDE VARIETY OF WINTER ACTIVITIES

There is a **wide variety** of winter activities to be enjoyed in Cortina so that everyone can find the right option: from alpine skiing and snowboarding to cross-country skiing and ski touring, from ice skating to ice climbing, from snowshoeing to hiking by candlelight.

A HEARTY CUISINE

The final touch that makes these activities unforgettable is the **local hearty cuisine**. The countless mountain huts and alpine farms scattered around town and on the mountains are not only a shelter but they can become a fundamental part of the holiday experience as it is possible to stay there overnight, watching incredible sunrises and sunsets, experience their traditional warm hospitality and the hearty cuisine. Many of them organize **snowmobile pick-ups** as well; this option is ideal for a relaxing day or for mixed groups where not everyone wants to go hiking, skiing or snowshoeing.

INDIVIDUAL & GROUP OPTIONS

Some of these activities are **individual**, others can be done also **in groups**. For beginners, there are always mountain professionals who will be able to make the experience even more enjoyable and safe. In the chapter "Useful information and services" you will find all the information and contact details of these mountain professionals and of the services needed: ski schools, mountain guides, skipass options, rental shops, transfer services, etc.

ALPINE SKIING & SNOWBOARDING

Cortina offers **120 km of pistes** of various difficulty levels, ideal for **beginner courses** (38 blue runs) as well as for independent **expert skiers** and **snowboarders** (13 black and 32 red runs). The highest piste is the Bus de Tofana (2,742 m), the longest is Armentarola (7.5 km) and the steepest is Forcella Rossa (62%). In addition, in the resort there are **3 ski tours**: spectacular itineraries to discover Cortina and the Dolomites on skis. On the slopes there are numerous **mountain lodges** (rifugi) and restaurants where it's possible to stop for a hot drink, for a short lunch break or for a longer gourmet experience, tasting the traditional cuisine, enjoying the wonderful views and in many cases also to **stay overnight** for a more encompassing experience or to experience a ski safari.



SKIPASS OPTIONS

There are **two skipass** options: the **Cortina skipass**, which gives access to the 3 main ski areas of Cortina (Tofana-Ra Valles, Faloria-Cristallo and 5 Torri-Lagazuoi) as well as to the slopes of San Vito di Cadore, Auronzo and Misurina, and the **Dolomiti Superski skipass**, which gives access to the whole carousel, for a total of 1,200 km of slopes and is particularly ideal for longer ski tours that include the neighboring valleys. Skipass holders can use the ski bus for free. Further info, group deals and contact details in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



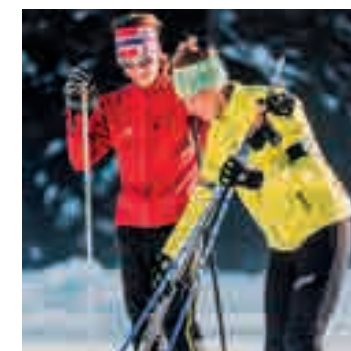
SKI SCHOOLS & INSTRUCTORS

In Cortina there are numerous **ski instructors** and **9 ski schools** with highly qualified ski and snowboard instructors, offering alpine skiing, snowboarding and telemark private and group lessons for all levels. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



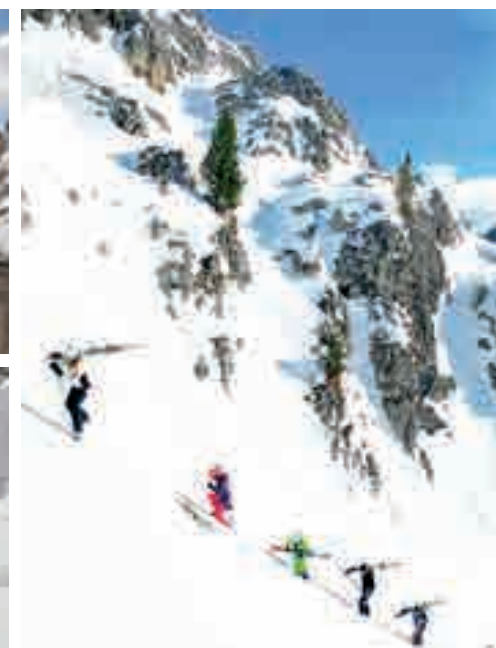
CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

Cortina's cross-country skiing pistes are suitable for beginners and experts alike: Cortina offers over **70 km of tracks** in two main areas (Fiammes Nordic Center and Tre Croci Pass), across the enchanting landscapes of the **Natural Park of the Ampezzo Dolomites**. Cortina is also part of the **Nordic Ski-skipass**, giving access to over **1,300 km of pistes** in Europe's largest cross-country ski carousel. At the Fiammes Nordic Center there is a cross-country ski school and rental store. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



SKI MOUNTAINEERING

This is the perfect activity for those who wish to **get away from the ski slopes** and immerse themselves in the peaceful landscapes of the magnificent snow-covered mountains, combining the pleasures of hiking and skiing. The highly-qualified local mountain guides offer a **wide variety of itineraries**, from easy ones to mountain lodges to more challenging outings on steep couloirs and multi-day hut-to-hut ski tours. For this activity it is essential that skiers have the proper **safety equipment** (avalanche transceiver, probe and shovel), available in the ski rental shops. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



FREERIDING

Freeriding is a form of skiing or snowboarding on **open terrain**, away from groomed slopes. Compared to ski touring, skiers can access numerous off-piste routes via **ski lifts** and don't have to hike uphill for long ascents. Cortina offers some of the best freeride areas, both in terms of **challenge** and **sheer beauty** for intermediate and experienced skiers who love the thrill of skiing in powder snow. Skiers trying freeriding should be accompanied by an **experienced mountain guides** and **ski instructors**. Guides not only know the resorts, but are also able to teach safety measures in case of avalanches and the best **technique** for skiing in deep powder snow. For this activity it is essential that skiers have the proper **safety equipment** (avalanche transceiver, probe and shovel), available in the ski rentals. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



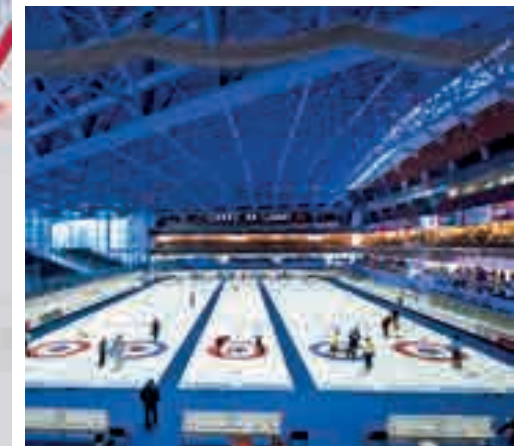


SNOWSHOEING

This is a **simple yet wonderful activity** that enables everyone to discover the snow-clad mountains, immersed in unspoilt settings. In Cortina there are **countless itineraries**: from easy tracks to mountain huts to long multi-day itineraries in the Natural Park of the Ampezzo Dolomites that can be undertaken with the local **mountain professionals**. The equipment is available in the local rental shops. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".

CURLING

At the Olympic Ice Stadium, it is possible to practise curling, a sport with a long tradition in Cortina. The structure hosted the **1956 Olympics** and in 2026 the curling competitions of the Milan Cortina 2026 Olympics will take place here once again. It is possible to book **curling lessons** for groups of at least 6 people. Further info and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



WINTER HIKING

Winter hiking is another option in addition to snowshoeing, ideal for everyone to explore the Ampezzo Valley, its mountain huts, frozen lakes and forests. There are several pleasant hikes in settings of breath-taking panoramic beauty, usually on prepared **groomed tracks** leading to **mountain huts** where it's possible to stop for a snack, hot drink or to savour a traditional local recipe at lunch or dinner.



ON THE SNOW BY NIGHT

Many activities, such as winter hiking, snowshoeing and ski touring, are also possible by night to explore the Ampezzo Dolomites under a starry sky, accompanied by Cortina's **mountain guides**. This experience will enable participants to discover the area at a different, unusual time, to really enjoy the **silence of nature** at night but also to savour a hearty meal in one of the many **mountain huts** along the itineraries. ICE SKATING

Ice skating can be practiced in Cortina both in winter and summer at the Olympic Ice Stadium, a large structure that hosted the **1956 Olympics** and was then modernized. In addition to the ice rink, there is an equipment **rental point**, a bar and the possibility to book a **lesson** with a qualified instructor. In some periods, and only with the right ice conditions, the possibility of ice skating is also given on lakes, such as **Lake Pianozes**.



SLEDDOG

In Cortina, it is possible to try the magical experience of sled dog driving through the snow-covered forests of the Ampezzo Dolomites. It is an absolute must for a **family outing**, **trip with friends** or even a **company excursion**.

After a theoretical introduction of driving, preparation of the sled and dog behaviour, the group will enjoy a 30 minutes ride on snow. The experience is available **upon reservation** and can only be confirmed with a **minimum number of participants** (10-15 people).

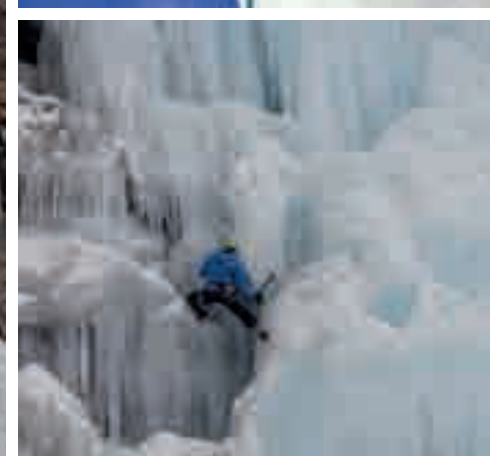


ICE CLIMBING

Ice climbing, a discipline arising from mountaineering, consists of **climbing frozen waterfalls** and ice walls with the aid of ice axes and crampons. Ice climbing allows the climbers to enter in a unique and fascinating dimension: there is a certain **unique thrill** that comes with scaling a giant ice waterfall. In the Ampezzo Valley there are several areas ideal for this activity, such as **Val Travenanzes** and **Valbona**.

The **mountain guides** of Cortina offer ice climbing lessons for beginners, who can learn the basic technique, and experts, who can climb multi-pitch waterfalls. It is also possible to organize lessons for **small groups**. Lastly, the rental shops have all the equipment needed (helmets, harnesses, crampons and ice axes).

SNOWKITING

Snowkiting is a sport where people use a kite to **"surf" on snow with skis** or a snowboard. In Cortina, this increasingly popular discipline can be done on the wide open spaces of the **Giau Pass**, ideal also because of its wind conditions. It is not only an **exciting** sport which gives a powerful **sense of freedom** but it also offers the opportunity to admire the wonderful Ampezzo Valley and the countless mountains surrounding it from above for a really unique experience. The activity is available starting from 15 years of age for individuals and small groups (3-4 people) upon reservation.

FAT BIKING

Fat Biking is a different way to explore the Dolomites immersed in a wonderful snowy landscape. Fat bikes have **special, thicker tyres** to be used on snow, providing a fun way to keep biking even in the snowy winter of the Dolomites. They are designed to go on snowy paths, at least partially compacted, along roads through the forest.

One of the best places to practise this sport is the area of **Col Gallina - Falzarego Pass**. **Bike instructors** are available to book individual and group lessons, as well as to rent fat bikes or e-fat bikes.

Compared to other mountain destinations, Cortina has a relatively large share of people choosing it because it offers **more than just sports and mountains**. This

makes it ideal for people with different interests as well as for **mixed groups** or **families** where not everyone might be into skiing or climbing. The many shops, the art galleries, the museums, the many bars, restaurants and wine bars, local traditions and crafts are a good addition for people who are looking primarily for sports but also a motivation for those looking to live a more pampered mountain experience.

UNIQUE EXPERIENCES

These activities are ideal to be offered for a **tailored touch** to your clients' holiday. A cooking class, a photo workshop, a visit to a local museum will add **something unique** that they will hardly experience on another trip. Other activities are ideal as a suggestion for free time or for a day spent differently.



CULINARY EXPERIENCES

Culinary experiences in Cortina are not limited to the destination's vast array of restaurants, mountain huts and farms. Guests can learn how to use local ingredients with the Course of **wild herbs** of Restaurant da Aurelio, or try **traditional** and **creative recipes** with a course by Michelin starred Restaurant Tivoli or at the Dining Experiences by Dolomiti Lodge Alverà. If they like cheese, they can attend the **cheesemaking** workshop by Piccolo Brite, which also offers the chance to have a picnic with zero-mile products. Restaurant SanBrite, Cortina's latest Michelin star, offers the experience of a lunch in its vegetable garden and the BriteMobile, with a **private chef** for a small group in a unique location. **Wine tastings** and pairings can be tried at Cortina's wine bars and in particular at the Dolom'Eats restaurant, in central Corso Italia, or at the Masi wine bar, high up on Col Drusciè. 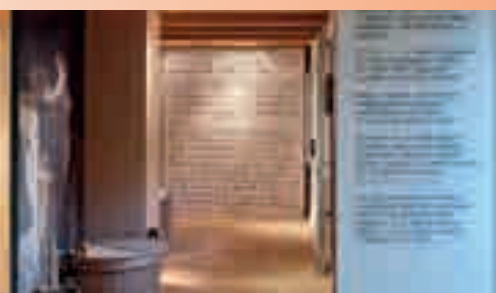
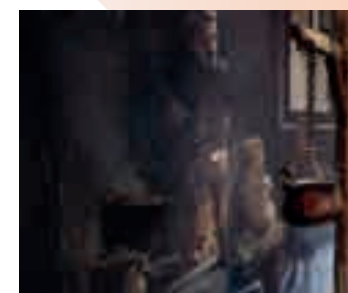
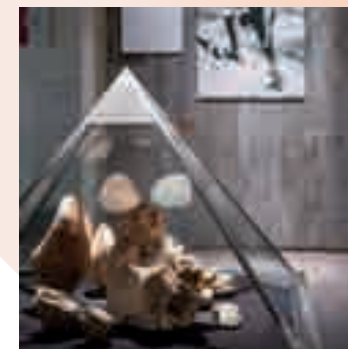
A holiday in Cortina is a great way to **relax** and feel good, and a wellness experience can help the process.

Besides the **spa areas** of several of **Cortina's hotels**, many of which are also open to the public, the town also offers wellness options at altitude: **Rifugio Lagazuoi's sauna** with a stunning view at over 2,700 m above sea level, **Rifugio Palmieri's sauna** just a few metres from the famous Lake Federa, the wood-fired hot tub and sauna of **Rifugio Mietres** and the wooden hot tub in front of the 5 Torri by **Rifugio Scoiattoli**. These experiences are especially fit for **small groups** or **families** and need to be **booked in advance**.

Another great option to relax and find one's balance is to organise an activity, for example a **yoga session at altitude**, with a wellness professional. For further information regarding hotels' spas, see the Accommodation section of this guide. For the other contacts, see the section "Useful contacts and services".

MUSEUMS

The destination boasts 3 museums in town owned and run by the local institution Regole d'Ampezzo. The **Palaeontological Museum Rinaldo Zardini** is small but very interesting: it showcases millions of years of history with one of the largest collections of fossils in existence. The **Modern art Museum Mario Rimoldi** constitutes one of the most important collections in Italy of 20th century art, with valuable paintings and other works. The **Ethnographic Museum** focuses on traditions and the collective management of natural resources, a central element of Cortina's history. Finally, **Cima Tofana** (3,244 m) hosts a Photo Exhibition about the history of mountain guides and alpinism in Cortina. THE GREAT WAR OPEN AIR MUSEUM

Cortina was on one of the battle lines of the First World War. The conflict saw the Italian and Austro-Hungarian armies fight for years, especially on the western side of the Ampezzo Valley. This area, which includes mountains such as the Cinque Torri, Lagazuoi, Sass de Stria, Tofane and Averau, is scattered with fortifications, tunnels and trenches which form the **Great War Open Air Museum**. **Group visits** can be organised by Cortina's guides or with reenactors. The museum is completed by the **Forte Tre Sassi**, a fort on the Valparola Pass, organising different exhibitions in an effort to keep the memory of those terrible years alive. Group tours can be organised. Further information and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".

EDELWEISS LANGUAGE & CULTURAL CENTRE - TRINITY CENTRE

In addition to English, German and Japanese the Centre offers Italian courses for foreign students and for anyone holidaying in Cortina who would like to attend only a few hours of Italian language lessons. The Centre also co-operates with **Tour Operators, Agencies, Schools** and other organisations wanting to set up study tours in Cortina d'Ampezzo and the Dolomites. ASTRONOMY

Thanks to a very active association of passionate amateur astronomers, Cortina has both a planetarium and an astronomical observatory.

The **Alessandro Dimai Planetarium** is located close to the town centre, in front of Cortina's Olympic Ice Stadium. Lessons and presentations on stars, planets and the universe can be organised in the structure, which has a capacity of around 60 people. Taking the Freccia nel Cielo gondola, not far from the planetarium, one can reach the **Helmut Ullrich Astronomical Observatory** on Col Druscié, at 1780 m. Guided visits can be organised at this facility, also in combination with a dinner at the nearby mountain hut.

STARS, SUNSETS AND SCENIC OVERNIGHTS

The Enrosadira, or alpenglow, is the phenomenon that makes the rocks of the Dolomites become a colour ranging from orange to pink. To catch this must-see, **Tofana Freccia nel Cielo** organises sunrise moments at Cima Tofana, above 3000 m, with early ascent by cable car and a sunrise breakfast at Rifugio Cima Tofana. Some mountain huts can organise sunrise and sunset moments for groups, with a dedicated breakfast, aperitivo or dinner. An even more unique experience is the **Starlight Room 360**, a glass and wood cabin located on the Col Gallina hills. A night in a Starlight Room, includes dinner and transport as well as unique emotions. Further information and contacts in the chapter "Useful contacts and services".



STAR-THEMED DINNERS

Three of Cortina's mountain huts, Rifugio Scoiattoli, Rifugio Col Druscié and Rifugio Averau, organise star-themed dinners. Located far from towns and major light sources, **Rifugio Averau** has obtained the Gold Certification of "I cieli più belli d'Italia" (Italy's most beautiful skies), awarding it as one of the best places in Italy to observe the night sky. The mountain hut organises special dinners with transportation and star observation with a telescope included. Similar dinners are organised also at **Rifugio Scoiattoli**, at the foot of the Cinque Torri. **Rifugio Col Druscié** organises dinners combined with a visit to Cortina's astronomical observatory, just a few steps away, to observe the moon or other celestial bodies.

ALEXANDER GIRARDI HALL

A multipurpose space reachable by foot from the town center, designed to be suitable to several needs: from **conference room** to cinema, **theater or concert hall**. Mountain huts (rifugi), also known as mountain lodges, are high-mountain buildings offering a bar and restaurant service and, in many cases, also rooms. Originally a foothold and restoration point for climbers and explorers, today Cortina's mountain lodges number over 30. Besides the traditional cooking, they offer a cosy atmosphere and enchanting views on the Dolomites. A night at a mountain lodge is a very authentic Alpine experience and allows guests to wake up at the starting point of the next hike or ski run. Mountain lodges vary greatly in capacity, with some having a few rooms and some others over 50 beds, and remoteness, being located in some cases close to a road or a lift and in some others in more isolated areas. Mountain lodges usually have two rooming options: shared dormitories or private rooms.
















Alpine farms (malghe) used to host shepherds in

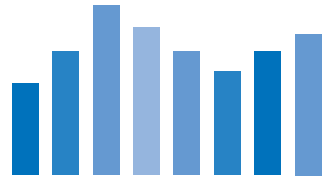
high-mountain pastures during the summer months. In the last few decades, some have been restored with restaurant and room services, and they still play a role in animal farming in the mountains and in environmental preservation.

Agriturismi are sort of farmhouses with a restaurant and, oftentimes, rooms. A part of the food served must be produced by the agriturismo itself, and some other bought from other agriturismi. This way, local production is encouraged and guests can experience the products of the destination in the most authentic way.

Cortina's agriturismi and Alpine farms are the recommended choice for a holiday deeply in touch with the destination and with local traditions. They usually have a limited number of rooms, for a very tailor-made experience.

MANY EVENTS TO ENTERTAIN CORTINA'S GUESTS ALL YEAR ROUND

Here is a list of the main events taking place in Cortina d'Ampezzo. Check the official website cortina.dolomiti.org in the section "Events" for further information.

JANUARY

LADIES SKI WORLD CUP

The World Cup takes place on the spectacular slope Olympia delle Tofane, where every year the best skiers worldwide compete in the Downhill and Super G races and where in February 2021 the Alpine FIS World Ski Championships took place.

FEBRUARY

GRANFONDO DOBBIACO - CORTINA

This popular cross-country ski race, loved by professional and amateur skiers alike, takes place on the perfectly groomed cross-country ski tracks along the scenic route of the former Dolomite railway, closed in 1962.

CARNIVAL

A rich programme of events featuring music, costumes, folklore, sport and gastronomy make this the most colourful celebration of the year. On Carnival Sunday and Shrove Tuesday, lively theatrical vignettes in the local language and colourful folkloristic floats, representing the different sestieri –neighbourhoods- of Cortina d'Ampezzo, line up in Corso Italia.

CORTINA C.A.I. SNOW RUN

The Italian Alpine Club, Cortina d'Ampezzo section, organises the Cortina Show Run, a mountain run competition, in semi-independence, at night along the beaten ski tracks of Cortina.

ITALIA POLO CHALLENGE

Polo is part of the history of Cortina and in recent winters it has come back to the destination with the Cortina Polo Challenge. The event, held in the sports area of Fiammes, brings together professional teams with the aim to increase the knowledge of this sport in Italy.

MARCH

WINTERACE

An annual rendezvous with this Super Classic ACI Sport event, reserved for 80 cars built within 1976. The teams compete on a 400 km course in 70 daytime time trials along Dolomite roads and passes, recreating an evocative old-timer atmosphere.

JUNE

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER CURLING TOURNAMENT

60 teams from all over the world and numerous fans fill the Olympic Ice Stadium for four thrilling days of competitions.

CORTINA - DOBBIACO RUN

The event takes runners along the route of the former Dolomite railway, with a spectacular departure from the bell tower in Cortina and arrival in Dobbiaco. This annual early-summer race draws thousands of top runners and amateurs from Italy and abroad.

LAVAREDO ULTRA TRAIL

The Lavaredo Ultra Trail is one of the most important and famous trail running races in the world. Every year it brings to Cortina d'Ampezzo thousands of athletes for the main race of 120 km, for the UltraDolomites (80 km), the Cortina Trail (48 km) and the Cortina Skyrace (20 km).

JULY

SAGRA D'AMPEZZO

Traditional local summer fest taking place on the first Sunday of July, with games, challenges (such as cutting the log) and a big street market.

COPPA D'ORO DELLE DOLOMITI (Dolomites Gold Cup)

13 Dolomite mountain passes, 4 regions, 76 vintage cars, one night-time stage and 509 km of motoring through magnificent landscapes are the key features of this famous event.

SESTIERI D'AMPEZZO FESTS

Traditional local summer fests taking place in each of the 6 neighbourhoods of Cortina from mid-July to the end of August, with colourful events, stalls, games, music and competitions: 6 fests in 6 different weekends to meet outdoors and enjoy traditional cuisine and dessert, different for each neighbourhood.

CORTINA TROPHY

The Cortina Trophy is an international competition bringing together thousands of MTB enthusiasts to the heart of Cortina for a breathtaking off-road marathon. The competition features two paths: a 76 km marathon and a 43 km Gran Fondo.

AUGUST

BEST OF THE ALPS GOLF CUP

A tournament that takes place on ten of the most fascinating and challenging golf courses of the Alps. Cortina d'Ampezzo, the only Dolomite resort among the 13 tourist destinations part of the Association, hosts the Italian stage of the tournament.

FERRAGOSTO

Ferragosto is a traditional Italian event celebrated on August 15th. In Cortina, some families or groups of friends organize on the evening of 14 of the big bonfires in a meadow or a viewpoint and invite friends and relatives to dine or have a drink outdoors.

FESTA DE RA BANDES

Traditional event of Cortina par excellence, this festival is a week dedicated to music: every day there are concerts of the Corpo Musicale Cortina, the local orchestra of Cortina d'Ampezzo, and the numerous guest bands. On the last day, in addition to the concerts, a parade takes place with the bands wearing traditional costumes.

SEPTEMBER

THE QUEEN OF TASTE

A festival dedicated to local chefs and food. The pedestrian area in the centre of Cortina becomes an open-air restaurant with tastings, Michelin-starred chefs' dishes and a few surprises.

DELICIOUS FESTIVAL DOLOMITI

A sporting, cultural and culinary event that aims at valuing Cortina's historical, natural, alpine and enogastronomic heritage. For two days, culinary arts and sport will come together for a series of trail running and climbing competitions, together with recipes prepared by local restaurant owners at the Pala Delicious in Pocol.

FIAT 500 GATHERING

In September, dozens of vintage Fiat 500 owners gather in Cortina for two days of panoramic tours and side events: two days in which Cortina, one of the most scenic Italian settings, and Fiat 500, a real emblem of an era, join as two style icons and symbols of Italian style and elegance.

OCTOBER

CATTLE DESCENT (Desmonteà)

In October, cows, donkeys, horses and sheep return to the village after a summer spent grazing on the pastures. On the day of the cattle descent, or Desmonteà, local farmers display their products in the town center and there is the opportunity to taste local products and to make a traditional lunch.

DECEMBER

CORTINA FASHION WEEKEND

Cortina greets the beginning of the winter season with the Fashion Weekend: three days of events on and off-piste, including presentations of new collections, special openings, cocktail parties, dj-sets and entertainment in many of Cortina's shops, boutiques, hotels and restaurants.

ST. NICHOLAS AND KRAMPUSES

Traditionally in Cortina it is not only Santa Claus who brings gifts to children, but also Saint Nicholas, whose feast is celebrated on December 5th. San Nicolò parades in the town center accompanied by angels but also by Krampuses, terrifying demonic creatures.

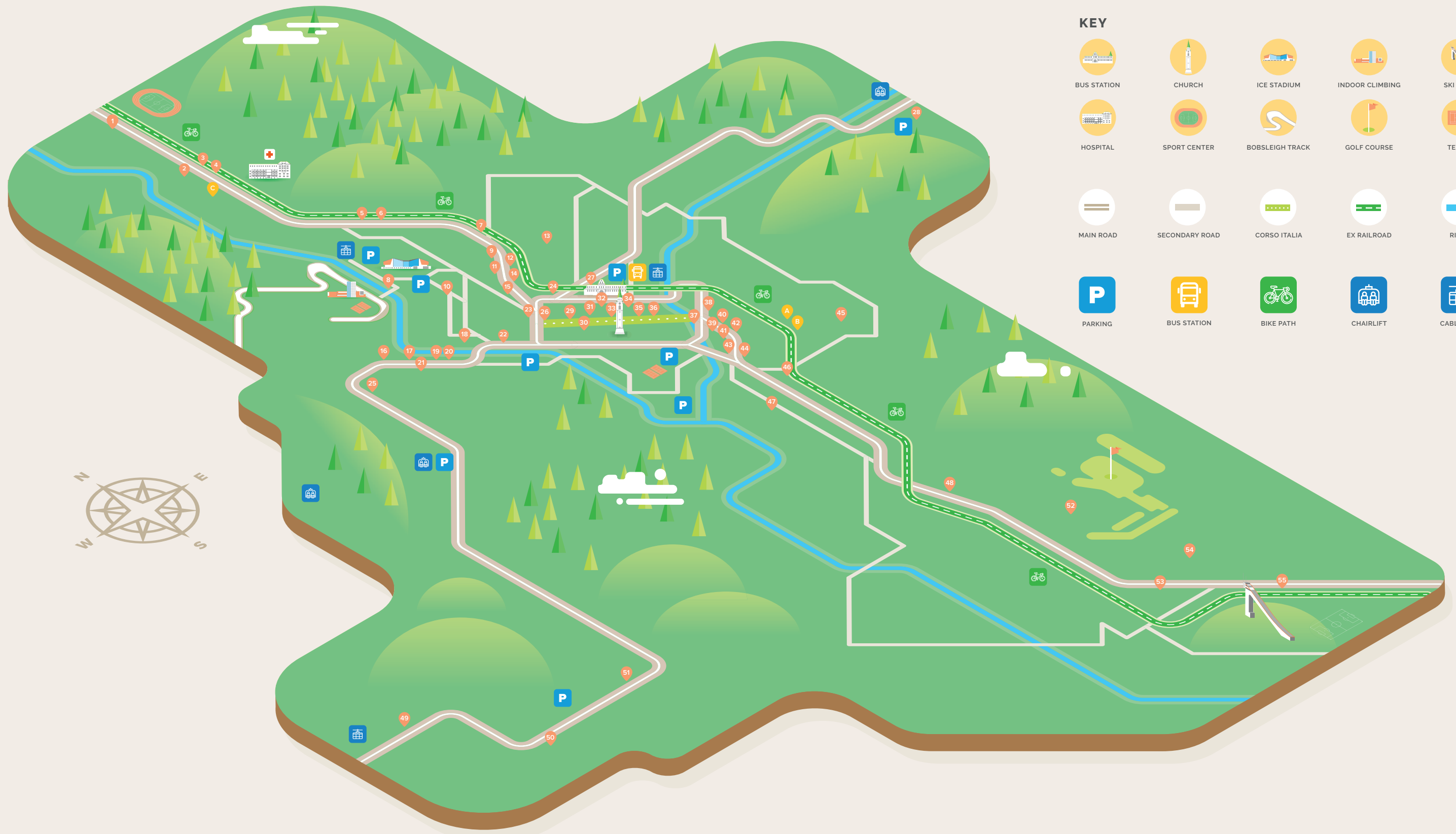
FIS SNOWBOARD WORLD CUP

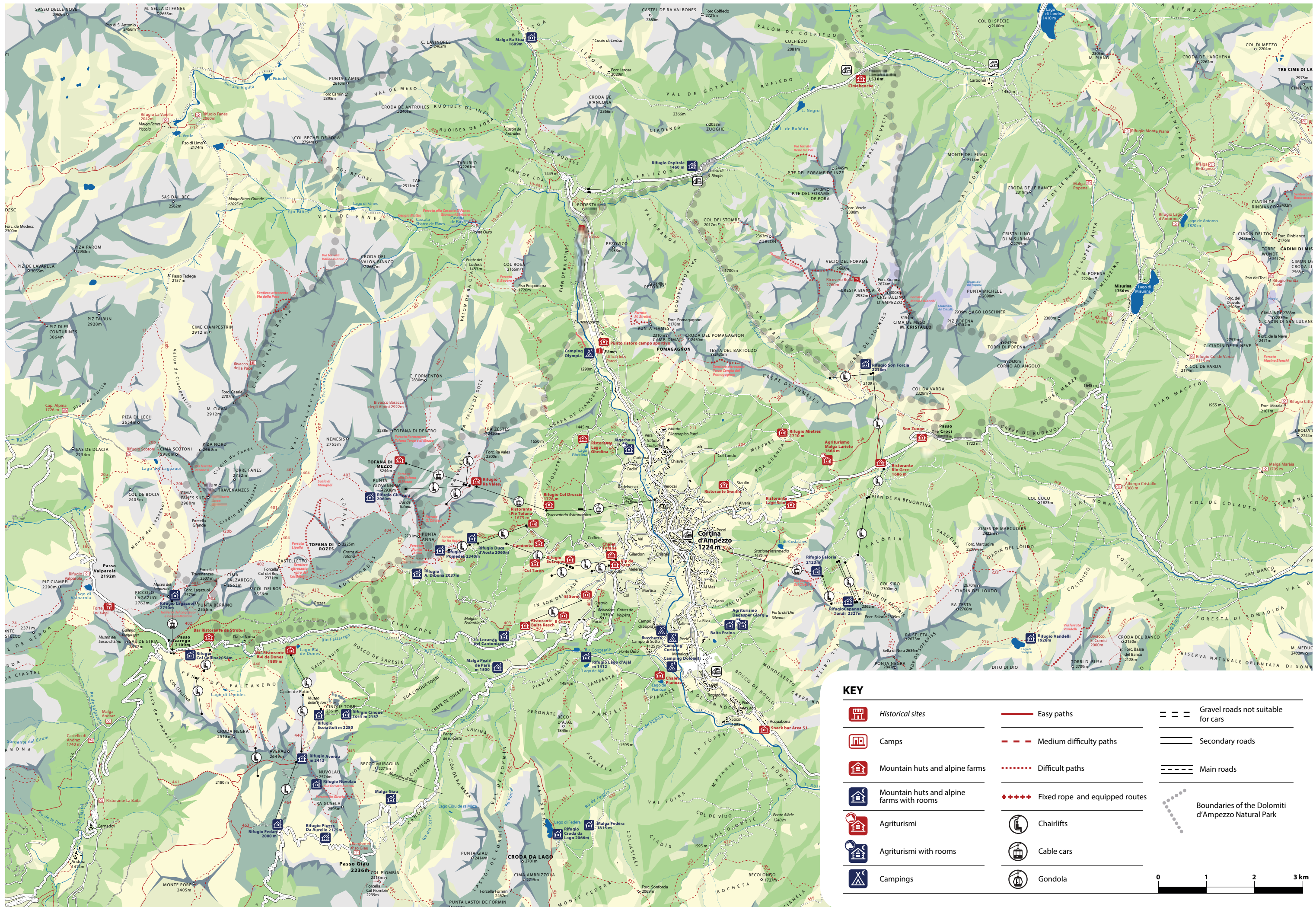
